Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 1 Arrival to Iceland

Individual transfer by Fly bus shuttle bus from Keflavik airport to your accommodation in Reykjavik. You may explore Iceland's capital city on your own if time allows. Overnight location: Hotel Cabin (Budget version, standard room is 10m²) or Hótel Klettur (Comfort version), or similar in Reykjavík. Dinner is on your own. (50km / 31mi).

Day 02: Day 2 Reykjavik City Tour, Blue Lagoon & Reykjanes Peninsula

At 09:00 meet your tour guide who shows the group the highlights of Iceland's exciting capital. Then we head out to the Reykjanes Peninsula with its hot springs, mountains, moon-like landscape, bird cliffs, lighthouses and fishing villages. In the afternoon we bathe in the Blue Lagoon. Drive along the south coast to arrive in the village of Hella where we stay for two nights in simple cottages. In the evening, we hear about the Northern Lights from our tour guide. Naturally, once darkness falls, you are out in the garden waiting for the Northern Lights. Overnight location: Stracta Hotel (Budget version, standard room is 18m²) / Stracta Hotel (Comfort version, studio room 24m²), Hella or similar . Breakfast included. Lunch & dinner is on your own. (220km / 137mi).

Day 03: Day 3 South Iceland with optional Glacier Hike & New Year's Celebration

Today we travel along the south coast. We reach the area beneath the Eyjafjallajökull volcano and glacier. We stop at Seljalandsfoss waterfall and visit Skógar folk museum of early Modern Iceland with its turf houses. At lunch, we visit the Skógarfoss waterfall. In the afternoon we offer an optional glacier hike. The hike is on the Sólheimajökull glacier tongue which extends from the great Mýrdalsjökull glacier. Booking for the hike is made directly with the operator. When booking make sure it is on the 3rd day of the tour and the 14:30 (02:30 pm) time slot. If you don't book the glacier hike, then the tour continues further south where you walk on the famous Black Lava Beach at Reynisfjara, observe the Cap of Dyrhólaey and the Reynisdrangar Sea Cliffs before visiting the charming village of Vík. In the evening we celebrate New Year the Icelandic way. Before dinner, join a guided bus tour to visit the bonfires in the villages of Hvolsvöllur and Hella. The traditional Brenna bonfires of New Year's Eve had their origins in the Middle Ages when people built bonfires to burn the old things they no longer needed. In Iceland, there are bonfires all around

the country where inhabitants gather, shoot off fireworks, sing and dance as they wait for the New Year to come in. Your festive dinner starts around 20:30 and is served at Stracta Hotel in Hella, which is a small village in South Iceland. Afterwards, we walk through the village and celebrate New Year's with a bang when at midnight the sky opens with thousands of fireworks set off in the village by the local inhabitants. This is an experience of a lifetime; you will never forget. Drink a toast of sparkling wine as you enjoy a real special Icelandic New Year's celebration. If the night is clear, you might be lucky enough to see the Northern Lights swirling in a wild and carefree dance across the heavens in dramatic shapes, colours, patterns and sizes. Overnight location: Stracta Hotel (Budget version, standard room is 18m²) / Stracta Hotel (Comfort version, studio room 24m²), Hella or similar. Breakfast included. Festive 4-course dinner (200km / 124mi).

Day 04: Day 4 Golden Circle & Culinary Experience

In the morning we learn about the Icelandic horse, its unique qualities and history and visit a geothermal greenhouse. Then we travel the Golden Circle route, see steam rising from the Geysir geothermal fields and admire the double waterfall of Gullfoss. We end the afternoon at Þingvellir National Park, the location of the ancient Viking Parliament and UNESCO World Heritage Site. The program includes a culinary treat at a restaurant located in the heart of downtown Reykjavík. Return transfer included. Overnight location: Hotel Cabin (Budget version, standard room is 10m²) or Hótel Klettur (Comfort version), or similar in Reykjavík. Breakfast included. Culinary dinner experience (200km / 124mi).

Day 05: Day 5 Departure Home

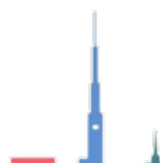
Individual transfer by Flybus shuttle bus from your accommodation in Reykjavik to Keflavik International Airport. Breakfast included. (50km / 31mi)

Tour Pick-up Time:: 08:45 on day 2 from Hotel Klettur & 09:00 from Hotel Cabin (subject to change).

Optional Glacier Hike: Duration of this activity is approximately 3 hours in total, about 90 minutes on the ice and about 30-40 min walk (one-way) from the car park to the glacier edge itself. The minimum age for the glacier hike is 10 years. You need to bring warm clothing, rain gear and hiking boots. Subject to availability and booked on the tour operators' website. (Subject to availability).

Children discount: 20% discount for children 8-11 years of age if sharing room with 2 adults. Tour is not recommended for children younger than eight years of age. Triple rooms are double rooms with an extra bed and ideal for two adults and one child.

NOTE: Itineraries may be subject to change at short notice during severe weather conditions and certain outdoor activities/day trips may be cancelled during the winter season in Iceland. In these rare cases, where situations of force majeure apply, excursions/activities cannot be refunded but the local guides will try their best to find reasonable alternatives where and whenever possible.
