### **Detailed Itinerary**

#### Day 01: Day 1 (Wed) – Arrival Transfer Beijing

Upon your arrival, meet your guide and transfer to your hotel The Presidential Beijing. Explore Beijing on your own. Meals: No Meals

### Day 02: Day 2 (Thu) – Tiananmen Square - Forbidden City - Summer Palace

In the morning after Breakfast The Tian'anmen Square is the world's largest and renowned public square where many historical events once took place. The Forbidden City (UNESCO) is the imperial place where the emperors of the Ming and Qing Dynasties ruled for nearly 500 years (1420-1911). Experience the architectural splendor of the palaces, ceremonial courtyards, and private quarters. The Summer Palace



(UNESCO) is the largest imperial garden in the world. Emperors of successive dynasties created a summer retreat of Chinese gardens and pavilions, around the tranquil waters of Kunming Lake. Meals:(B/L/-)

#### Day 03: Day 3 (Fri) – Great Wall - A Jade Stone Workshop - Bird's Nest & Water Cube

The Great Wall is one of the most spectacular structures ever built by humans and is the only one visible from space. Take an outside tour to the Olympic Stadium, nicknamed Bird's Nest, and the National Swimming Centre, also known as the Water Cube. Meals: (B/L/-)

#### Day 04: Day 4 (Sat) – Temple of Heaven - A Pearl Workshop - Hutong Tour

The Temple of Heaven (UNESCO), where ancient Chinese emperors made sacrifices to Heaven and prayed for bountiful harvests, demonstrates the supreme achievement of traditional Chinese architecture. Take a Hutong Tour to explore the oldest part of the city and gain insight into the traditional lifestyle and customs. Meals: (B/L/-)

#### Day 05: Day 5 (Sun) – Transfer Beijing - Xian -

Hotel - Airport Transfer in Beijing, Airport transfer in Xi'an Fly to Xi'an. The Shaanxi History Museum, a national comprehensive museum in Xi'an, highlights the development of Chinese civilization more than 5,000 years. The Big Wild Goose Pagoda, a Tang Dynasty landmark, is a seven-story pagoda initially constructed in 652 AD. One of the pagoda's many functions is to hold sutras and figurines of the Buddha that were brought to China from India by the Buddhist translator and traveler - Xuanzang. Stay at the Jian Guo Hotel Xian. Meals: (B/L/-)

# Day 06: Day 6 (Mon) – Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses - A Ceramic & Pottery Workshop - Dumpling Banquet & Tang Dynasty Show

Full day excursion to the Terracotta Warriors Museum, and visit to the ceramics & pottery workshop en route. The Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses (UNESCO) is one of the greatest archaeological discoveries in the world. More than 6000 life-sized terra cotta warriors, archers, infantrymen, horses, and bronze chariots have silently guarded the tomb of China's First Emperor for over 2,200 years. Enjoy the Dumpling Dinner and Tang Dynasty Show tonight. Meals: (B/L/TD)

#### Day 07: Day 7 (Tue) – Xian - Chengdu

Hotel-Train station transfer in Xi'an, Train station transfer in Chengdu Take the bullet train to Chengdu. Visit to the ancient street and mingle with the local people. Stay at the Tibet Hotel in Chengdu. Meals: (B/L/-)



## Day 08: Day 8 (Wed) – Chengdu - Giant Panda Breeding Research Center - People's Park

Visit to the Grant Panda Breeding Base and the Peoples Park. The Giant Panda Breeding Research Center is a massive ecological and zoological park offers a wonderful chance to get face-to-face with China's national treasure. There is also a panda museum that has detailed exhibitions on panda evolution, habits, habitats and conservation efforts. The People's Park, also called Renmin Park, is located in central Chengdu. If you want to know more about local people's life, this park is the absolutely your best choice. Meals: (B/L/-)

#### Day 09: Day 9 (Thu) Chengdu - Leshan Giant Buddha

Day trip to visit the Leshan Giant Buddha The Leshan Giant Buddha is an enormous 230-feet Buddha, which is the largest stone-carved Buddha in the world. You will board a boat and head out into the Mingjiang River to get an overall view of the statue from afar. Meals: (B/-L/-)

#### Day 10: Day 10 (Fri) – Transfer Chengdu - Shanghai

Fly to Shanghai. Meet and transfer to the Ocean Hotel Shanghai. The rest of the day on own. Meals: (B/-/-)

# Day 11: Day 11 (Sat) – Shanghai Yu Garden - Shanghai Museum - Bund - Xintiandi Street - Pudong New Area

Full day visit to the Yu Garden, Shanghai Museum, the Bund, Xintiandi and Pudong New Development Zone Owing to its ingenious design in Ming and Qing dynasties, the Yu Garden becomes a real museum of Chinese ancient architecture. The Shanghai Museum has a collection of 120,000 pieces of Chinese ancient treasures. The Bund, featured outstanding European colonial architectures, is full of new skyscrapers and historical buildings in the center of Shanghai. Take a stroll along the Xintiandi Street, a boutique area highlights a harmonious merger of classic and modern Shanghai. Pudong New Area is home to the Lujiazui Finance and Trade Zone and the Shanghai Stock Exchange and many of Shanghai's best-known buildings, such as the Oriental Pearl Tower, the Jin Mao Tower, the Shanghai World Financial Center, and the Shanghai Tower. These modern skyscrapers directly face Puxi's historic Bund, a remnant of former foreign concessions in China. Meals: (B/L/-)

# Day 12: Day 12 (Sun) – Shanghai - Suzhou - Shanghai - (Master of Nets Garden - A Silk Factory - Pingjiang Road)

The Master of Nets Garden, the smallest and most proportional of all the beautiful gardens in Suzhou, is in the mood of tranquility and harmony. Pingjiang Road, a ancient street along the Grand Canal, is filled with snack shops, tea houses, ping-tan museums, and boutique shops. Excursion to the water town Suzhou, including the Garden of Master of Nets, Silk Spinning Factory and Pingjiang Road Old Town Area Meals: (B/L/-)
