Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 1: Arrive in Siem Reap

Sua s'dei! Welcome to Cambodia! Pick up at Siem Reap International Airport by local guide and transfer to hotel in Siem Reap Rest of the day is free at leisure. Overnight in Siem Reap. Note: Hotel's check-in time is 14:00 Meals: No Meals

Day 02: Day 2: Siem Reap At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. The day is free for your own arrangement. Overnight in Siem Reap Optional tour 1: Full day Temple tour Visit the South Gate of Angkor Thom and marvel the wonders of the eerie Bayon, Baphuon, Phimeanakas, Terrace of Elephants and Terrace of Leper King. Continue to Ta Prohm. Unlike most of the other Angkor temples, Ta Prohm has been left like it was founded. The photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made it one of Angkor's most



popular temples with visitors. In the afternoon, visit the famous Angkor Wat, built for king Suryavarman II in the early 12th century as his state temple and capital city. The largest and best-preserved temple at the site, it is the only one to have remained a significant religious centre – first Hinduism, then Buddhism since its foundation. Enjoy the superb view of sunset from Pre Rup. Duration: 10 hours Inclusion: Private transfer in air-conditioned vehicle, Local English speaking guide, Sightseeing fees, Mineral water & towels Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 03: Day 3: Siem Reap At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. The day is free for your own arrangement. Overnight in Siem Reap Optional tour 2: Half day Tonle Sap tour Duration: 4 hours/ available daily In the morning, you will head out to Mechrey "floating village". Take a boat and cruise through this floating settlement seeing a floating school, farms, houses and many more curiosities. Greeted by waves of the friendly locals, here you can glimpse Cambodia's lakeside culture and traditional family lifestyle. Note: In dry season (Mar-Sep), when the water is low clients will visit Chong Kneas floating village instead Tour ends around 12.00 pm / or 18.00pm Inclusion: Private transportation with air-conditioned, Local English speaking guide, Sightseeingfees, Mineral water and towels Exclusion: Visa, Travel Insurance, Hotel accommodation in Siem Reap, Peak tourist season or special event rates, Tip, Drinks and other personal expenses Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 04: Day 4: Siem Reap At Lleisure

Breakfast at hotel. The day is free for your own arrangement. Overnight in Siem Reap Optional Tour 3: Tree planting in Preah Dak and Banteay Srei This morning, we will travel by car to Preah Dak village and join villagers to plant trees in the community. After that, we continue to visit Banteay Srey loosely translates to 'citadel of the women,' but this is a modern appellation that probably refers to the delicate beauty of the carvings and Banteay Samre is a bit off the Grand Circuit, near the southeast corner of the East Baray. Duration: 4 hours Inclusion:Private transportation with air-conditioned, Local English speaking guide, Sightseeing fees, Mineral water and towels Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 05: Day 5: Siem Reap – Phnom Penh

After breakfast and check-out, you will be transferred to bus station and get on public bus to Phnom Penh. Upon arrival, driver pick you and transfer to hotel to check in. Overnight in Phnom Penh Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 06: Day 6: Phnom Penh At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. The day is free for your own arrangment. Overnight in Phnom Penh. Optional Tour 4: Biking tour to Koh Dach / Silk Island Duration: 4 hours/ available daily You will be picked up by private vehicle from your hotel in the morning, get acquainted with the features of your bike. Follow your private guide over the Tonle Sap River and cycle along the riverbank past communities of the Cham ethnic-minority



group. You'll catch a ferry across the Mekong River to Koh Dach, known as Silk Island, where village artisans make their living weaving silk into beautiful creations. (Alternatively, you can arrange to transfer to the ferry by minivan and begin your bicycle tour on the island.) When you arrive at Koh Dach, a typical Khmer village, marvel at the houses built high on stilts with workshops below. Meet some of the families that still maintain the old traditions of hand looming silk and dying it with bright hues. You'll be amazed by the homemade spinning wheels made from old bicycle parts! Watch as the silk is transformed from a cotton-like texture into thread, and try your hand at weaving if you'd like. Before hopping back on your bike, you can browse for silk items available for purchase directly from the villagers. Visit the local temple, Wat Chung Koh, and have a chat with local monks before cycling a short distance to a picnic spot for lunch. Enjoy Khmer-style dishes until you hop back on your bike for the return to Phnom Penh in the afternoon, when your private guide drops you off at your hotel. Cycling distance: approximately 15 km (mostly flat ground) Inclusion: Private transportation with air-conditioned, mountain bike, truck carry bike (apply for group 4paxs up), snack/fruit, picnic lunch, Local cycling English speaking guide, Sightseeing fees, Mineral water and towels Meals: (B/-/-)

Day 07: Day 7: Phnom Penh At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. The day is free for your own arrangement. Overnight in Phnom Penh Meals: (B/-/-)

Day 08: Day 8: Phnom Penh – Kep

After breakfast and check out, you will be transferred to bus station without guide to get on public bus to Kep. Upon arrival, driver pick you and transfer to hotel to check in. Overnight in Kep. Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 09: Kep At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. These days are free at leisure or you can join some optional tour for half day or full day. Overnight in Kep Optional tour 5: Hike the Kep National Park This morning we go explore Kep national park on a gentle hike. We start early and tread lightly on the earthen pathways of the park. If you want a little extra challenge, there is an opportunity to take the Transverse Trail across a thick jungle. We will end the morning with a refreshment at the Led Zep Café, which owner is also the founder of the Squirrel Association, marking and maintaining trails in the throughout the national park. Inclusion: Private transportation with airconditioned, Local English speaking guide, Sightseeingfees, Mineral water and towels Meals: (B/-/-)

Day 10: Day 10: Kep At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. These days are free at leisure or you can join some optional tour for half day or full day. Overnight in Kep Optional tour 6: Kayak the Kampot River This morning, we head out for another exciting adventure. After a transfer to Kampot, we get equipped and hop on kayaks to paddle gently down the Kampot River. As we glide in silence on the waters, we pass by some rapids, some stretches of mangrove as well as



rural villages offering us to witness some slices of daily life by the river. We will have cold drinks with us and lots of fun. Inclusion: Private transportation with air-conditioned, Local English speaking guide, Sightseeingfees, Kayak, Mineral water and towels Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 11: Day 11: Kep At Leisure

Breakfast at hotel. These days are free at leisure or you can join some optional tour for half day or full day. Overnight in Kep Meals:(B/-/-)

Day 12: Day 12: Kep – Phnom Penh

After breakfast, get on public bus to Phnom Penh Meals:(B/-/-)
