Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 1 Friday Ben Gurion Airport / Tel Aviv

Arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, where you will be met by a our representative and transferred to your hotel.
Overnight in Tel Aviv.

Day 02: Day 2 Saturday At leisure

Overnight in Tel Aviv.

Day 03: Day 3 Sunday Caesarea / Megiddo / Druze village / Haifa

Drive along the coastal plain to Caesarea, once the Roman capital of the region; See the excavations of the Crusaders' city, the Roman port, aqueduct and the amphitheater that has been restored to its former glory as a concert venue. Proceed to Megiddo, identified as the site of Armageddon; Visit the archaeological excavations including the well-preserved water supply system. Continue to Daliat-el-Carmel, a Druze village and enjoy a late lunch at a local restaurant. Proceed via Mount Carmel to Haifa for a panoramic view of the Haifa bay and the golden domed Bahai shrine and gardens. Overnight in a Kibbutz guesthouse.

Day 04: Day 4 Monday Safed / Golan Heights / Winery

Drive to Safed, the center of Jewish mysticism; Visit the ancient synagogues and the artists' colony. Continue to the Golan Heights to see the former Syrian bunkers, Kuneitra and the new Israeli town of Katzrin. Stop at the Golan Winery for a tour and wine tasting; Proceed to "Golan Magic", for a multimedia presentation of the area and its history . Overnight in a Kibbutz guesthouse.

Day 05: Day 5 Tuesday Sea of Galilee / Nazareth

Start the day with a visit to Nazareth; Visit the Church of Annunciation; Continue to Tiberias; Visit Capernaum to see the ruins of the synagogue and octagonal Church of St. Peter; Visit Mount of Beatitudes, where Jesus delivered the sermon on the mount . Drive via Beit Shean to Beit Alpha to see the remains of the mosaic floor of an ancient synagogue depicting the zodiac. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 06: Day 6 Wednesday Jerusalem (Old City)

Start the day with a magnificent panoramic view from Mount of Olives. Drive to the Old City; Visit the Tomb of King David and the Room of Last Supper on Mt. Zion. Enter the walled city and walk through the newly restored Jewish quarter. Visit the Roman Cardo, the Herodian quarter and continue to the Western Wall. Walk along the Via Dolorosa to the Church of Holy Sepulchre. Continue to Bethlehem*; view Rachel's tomb and proceed to visit the Church of Nativity and Manger's Square. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 07: Day 7 Thursday Jerusalem (New City)

Drive to the Israel Museum; Visit the Shrine of the Book, where the Dead Sea scrolls are housed, and the miniature model of Jerusalem as it was during the Second Temple period; Proceed for a tour at the Knesset, Israel's parliament. Continue to visit Mount Hertzal cemetery and Yad Vashem, the memorial to the Holocaust . Drive through Mea Shearim, the ultra orthodox neighborhood in Jerusalem and learn about their

unique lifestyle. In the evening enjoy a middle eastern dinner followed by the spectacular "Sound & Light" show** at the Tower of David Museum. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 08: Day 8 Friday Qumeran / Massada / Dead Sea

Drive through the Judean desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth, almost 1300 feet (400 meters) below sea level. Stop at Qumeran to visit the site where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea to Massada. Ascend by cable car and tour the ancient fortress where the Zealots made their last stand against the Romans before committing mass suicide in 73 AD. Descend by cable car. Continue to the Dead Sea; Cover yourself with the mineral rich mud and experience a swim in the Dead Sea** that many believe has its therapeutic effects. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 09: Day 9 Saturday At leisure

Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10: Day 10 Sunday Jerusalem / Sheikh Hussein Bridge / Jerash / Amman ***

Drive from Jerusalem to the Sheikh Hussein border crossing for procedures to enter Jordan. Proceed to Jerash - city of the Decapolis, located about 45km north of Amman in the fertile heights of the Gilad. Visit the ancient Roman city with colonnaded streets, the baths and the hill of the top Temple etc. Drive to Amman for a panoramic city tour of the Jordanian capital. Overnight in Amman.

Day 11: Day 11 Monday Amman / Petra

After early breakfast, leave the hotel and travel south on the road to Wadi Musa, the modern village of Petra. Ride on horseback to the "Siq" (canyon) and then on foot to Petra, known as "Sela Edom" or red rock city, the ancient capital of the Nabateans from 3rd century B.C. to 2nd Century A.D. Visit the most interesting monuments such as the Treasury, El Khazneh (a tomb of a Nabatean king) then the field of tombs, obelisks, the altar, (Al Madhbah) - from this point you can view the whole of the rock city, then back to Wadi Musa village. Overnight in Petra.

Day 12: Day 12 Tuesday Amman / Madaba / Mt. Nebo / Tel Aviv

Drive to Madaba to see the ancient mosaic map of the Holy Land and ruins of historical sites. Continue about 10kms to Mount Nebo, from where Moses viewed the Promised Land. From there you will see the Jordan Valley, Jericho and the Dead Sea etc. Visit the remains of the Byzantine church with a mosaic floor. Drive to the border and onwards to Tel Aviv. Overnight in Tel Aviv.

Day 13: Day 13 Wednesday Tel Aviv / Ben Gurion Airport

After breakfast, transfer to Ben Gurion Airport for departure.

- Sharing transfer on arrival and departure (from/to Ben Gurion Airport) - Transfer to and from the Jordan border - 12 nights accommodation on BED & BREAKFAST basis except Kibbutz Lavi and Jordan on HALF BOARD basis (Due to availability, the second night in Jordan might take place in Amman instead of Petra) - 9 touring days as per itinerary, with English speaking guide - Lunch at a Druze village on Sunday - Dinner in Jerusalem on Thursday followed by a Sound and Light show at David Citadel - Entrance fees to the sites visited as per itinerary
