Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: DAY 1: WELCOME TO PANAMA CITY

Meet & Greet upon arrival and transfer to your hotel in the capital. This country that links American continent and owns the 8th wonder of the modern world "The Panama Canal" will surprise you! Prepare for meeting beautiful landscapes, cosmopolitan and colonial cities, pristine islands, tradition, culture, rain forest and Indian communities.

Day 02: DAY 2: ROUTE PANAMA CITY - PORTOBELO

Portobelo is in the Province of Colon, which lies on the North of Panama and bordered by the Caribbean Sea. This province is full of historical anecdotes from the colonial era. Its name evokes the first Spanish expeditions to the West Indies searching for the galleon routes. Walking through the ruins of Forts Portobelo, you will be transported in time to the attacks of corsairs and pirates of the Old Continent. Today the region is full of natural sites of outstanding beauty, deserted beaches and forgotten people. Drive 2hrs approx. Panama City - Portobelo

Day 03: DAYS 3: HISTORIC TOUR OF PORTOBELO & CONGO DANCE SHOW

Learn more about the history and magic of this ancient city in the company of one of our guides; It will show you the ruins of its famous colonial forts, the historic Customs House, the Church of the Black Christ and other points of interest declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO while you stroll through the village to soak up the Afro-Caribbean Congo Culture.Duration: about 3hrs. Discovering Portobelo with a local English-speaking guide

Day 04: DAYS 4: PORTOBELO

Day at leisure. Situated at the north of the provinces of Panama and surrounded by the Caribbean Sea, Colon region is full of history from the colonial times. Discover the fortress of San Lorenzo and Portobelo and learn about the attacks of corsairs and pirates of the Old Continent. Activities and tours suggested to be organized locally: • Visit historic sites (World Heritage of UNESCO sites) • Tours to Isla Grande and Isla Mamei. • Riding or hiking in the National Park Portobelo; • Snorkeling • Kayak, Diving

Day 05: DAYS 5: ROUTE PORTOBELO – PEDASÍ

The Central provinces are considered as the nerve center of traditions and folklore. The Azuero Peninsula offers pastures, small villages and many other treasures. Known for its carnival (in February) and his famous dresses "polleras" this part of the country deserves your attention. Drive 5hrs 45mins approx. Portobelo - Pedasí



Day 06: DAYS 6: VISITING NATIONAL PARK IGUANA ISLAND

Transfer to Playa El Arenal in Pedasí, where your boat takes you to Iguana Island. Enjoy some relaxing time at the beach in this beautiful Island. The island is famous for its white sand beach, crystal waters, extensive mangrove forests and coral riffs including 12 different types of corals that shelter more than 300 species of fish. Dolphins are frequently seen, as well as (harmless) sharks, turtles. Duration: 7-8 hrs aprox grouped service, including picnic with an English-speaking local guide and entrance fee.

Day 07: DAYS 13: PEDASÍ

Day at leisure The Pacific side of the Azuero Province offers pristine islands and beaches perfect for surfing. These coasts invite you to magical events of nature: the birth of Humpback whales and the nesting of 5 different species of turtles. Activities and tours suggested to be organized locally in Pedasi: • Visit of the Pollera Museum in Los Santos • Pottery and Crafts. • Whale watching tour (between June and October) • Turtle watching tour (peak for Pacific Season: turtle nesting from July to November) • Snorkeling • Surf • Fishing • Visit Cañas Island • Visit Venao Beach • Visit Los Destiladeros Beach • Visit El Arenal Beach • Visit Sarigua National Park • Visit National Park Iguana Island

Day 08: DAY 8: ROUTE PEDASÍ - BOQUETE Drive

This Region and its charming villages are famous because of its biodiversity and fresh climate. Chiriqui hosts the Amistad and Volcan Barú national parks that represent the perfect meeting point for hikers and lovers of mountains and nature. Be delighted by beautiful landscapes, adventure and flavours of one of the best coffees of the world! Drive 5hrs15 approx. Pedasí - Boquete

Day 09: DAY 9: HALF-DAY HIKING TOUR

Take a walk with a local guide to observe wildlife and flora in one of the beautiful trails of the region searching for the Quetzal! Your guide will adapt the tour according to your physical condition. Duration: about 4 hours with private round-trip transfers in a grouped service with Spanish speaking driver.

Day 10: DAY 10: BOQUETE

Day at leisure Activities and tours suggested to be organized locally: • Horseback riding • Tasting of honey and "guarapo" (sugar cane juice) • Hanging Bridges tour • Trekking and hiking • Birdwatching • Coffee tour • Tea tour • Rafting • Zip line or canopy • Hiking Baru Volcano • Visit Islands in the Gulf of Chiriqui • Visit Los Cangilones to Gualaca • ATV tours • Visit the Ngobe indigenous community

Day 11: DAY 11: ROUTE BOQUETE - ALMIRANTE



Bocas del Toro is an archipelago that Christopher Columbus landed during his 4th journey searching for the West Indies in 1502; therefore, many islands are named before him. Join us to discover one of the first touristic destinations of Panama: BOCAS DEL TORO! This province consists of perfect places to practice water sports or simply relax. Drive 3hrs30 approx. Boquete - Almirante Grouped boat transfer 30m approx. Almirante - Isla Colón Local transfer 5 approx. port - hotel

Day 12: DAYS 12: DISCOVER THE BEACHES OF THE ARCHIPELAGO

Early departure to visit three beautiful beaches of the Caribbean. Admire an incredible marine life (dolphins, turtles, tropical frogs, goldfish, amazing colors tropical fish and corals) Ride the Caribbean waves and walk on white deserted beaches. Round-trip local transfer 10 approx. hotel-port About 5hrs grouped boat tour including snorkeling equipment, round-trip transfer, and entrance fee.

Day 13: DAY 13: BOCAS DEL TORO ARCHIPELAGO

Day at leisure Suggested activities and excursions to organize on site at BOCAS DEL TORO: • Diving • Snorkeling • Surfing • Hiking in Isla Bastimentos National Park. • Mangrove Tower and Salt Creek Village Tour • Visit Cayo Zapatillas National Park, Coral Cay and Dolphin Bay • Tree climbing at Red frog • Visit of a Ngobe indigenous community • Chocolate tower • Tour lament and turtles in San San Pond Sak

Day 14: DAY 14: VISIT OF CASCO VIEJO & PANAMA CANAL

This day return by domestic a flight to Panama City. Continue wih a Half-Day City Tour: Explore the colonial area with a private guide: The Casco Viejo, neighborhood declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1980. Walk through the streets of Casco Viejo and visit different historic monuments, France Square (beautiful view of the modern city) and Bolivar Square. Continue to Miraflores, where you can follow the technical operations of the canal locks from a platform. The Miraflores locks, is one of the 3 set of locks of the Panama Canal and lies in the Pacific side. Visit Casco Viejo & the Panama Canal Duration: about 4 hours with private transfer in private service with Spanish-speaking driver. Non-included entrance fees.

Day 15: Day 15: DEPARTURE

Private transfer to the international airport. 30 min Private transfer to the international airport of Tocumen
