### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Itineraries are subject to change depending on weather conditions and the season

- Iquitos is hot and humid. Temperatures range between 33°C (90°F) and 21°C (70°F).
- Rainy season (high water): November–May > Dry season (low water): June–October.
- Clothing: Light and loose-fitting garments > blouses > swimsuits > rubber soled shoes for the boat > knit jackets or long-sleeve shirts > windbreakers (gumboots and rain capes are provided by Aria).
- We recommend taking vitamin B or B-15 a few days before your arrival in the jungle, as this is the best



natural repellent against biting insects.

- There is no Internet, WIFI, or regular telephone signal on the boat.
- Tips for guides and staff are not included and are expected by both the crew & the guides separately.
- We recommend bringing protective insect repellent > sunscreen > hat > sunglasses > binoculars > camera and spare batteries
