Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 01: Copenhagen

Arrival in Copenhagen, a modern capital but with strong roots in the past. It is welcoming, dynamic, lively and charming, and it is also an ideal base to explore Denmark. Accommodation in 3* hotel in Copenhagen city center

Day 02: Day 02: Copenhagen – Helsingor- Roskilde

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure for the castle of Kronborg, also known as Hamlet's castle. You will continue to Hillerod and Frederiksborg Castle, where you will now find the Danish National Museum of History. Continue your journey to reach the city of Roskilde with its famous cathedral, dating from the twelfth century. In addition, you can visit the Viking Ship Museum. Accommodation in 3* hotel Roskilde City center

Day 03: Day 03: Roskilde – Odense

Breakfast at the hotel. Today, you will cross the longest bridge in Europe, Storebæltsbroen, connecting the island of Sealand to Funen. On arrival in Odense, you will discover the city of Hans Christian Andersen, a Danish writer and poet, famous for his fairy tales. Accommodation in 3* hotel in Odense

Day 04: Day 04: Odense – Århus

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you will head west and reach a small but nevertheless well-known place in Denmark, Billund. Billund is home of the famous Legoland: a miniature world built entirely of Lego. Then continue north-east to Aarhus, one of the great cities of Jutland where an open-air museum, Den Gamle By, is located. This museum is devoted to culture and customs of local people from 1500 until today. Accommodation in 3* hotel in Århus

Day 05: Day 05: Århus - Skagen

Breakfast at the hotel. Then start your journey north to discover Skagen where the land narrows to become a sandbank battered by the waves of two seas. Accommodation in 3* hotel in Skagen

Day 06: Day 06: Skagen - Kolding

Breakfast at the hotel. Today your journey continues south to the town of Kolding. The most important monument of the city is the castle Koldinghus which has been, over the years, a fortress, a royal residence, ruins and a museum. Accommodation in 3* hotel in Kolding

Breakfast at the hotel. This day is dedicated to visiting the beautiful capital of Denmark.
