Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 1 - Frankfurt - Heidelberg

Arrival in Frankfurt. Take the train to Heidelberg

Day 02: Day 2 - Heidelberg - Neustadt a.d. Weinstrasse

Train ride to the city of Neustadt a.d. Weinstraße (approx. 1h), capital of the region palatinate and one of the main wine-producing centers in Germany. From here it is only 15 minutes to Bad Dürkheim, where the largest Wine Festival in the world takes place for 9 days! Enjoy the best variety of wines in one of the traditional festival tents accompanied by traditional and cheerful music.

Day 03: Day 3 - Neustadt a.d. Weinstrasse

Today a wine tasting waits for you in one of the best known wineries in the area. Afterwards you have to option to go back to the Wine Festival or to go on an excursion to the nearby city of Speyer (Speyer) with its impressive cathedral.

Day 04: Day 4 - Neustadt - Frankfurt

Take the train from Neustadt to Frankfurt.
