Day 01: DAY 1: Matusadona National Park

Aboard your shared flight to Matusadona National Park One of several protected wildlife areas on the shores of the Lake, Matusadona is bounded on the west by the Ume River and on the east by the Sanyati River. Remote and isolated, the park receives fewer tourist numbers and provides an exclusive game viewing experience. Well known for its large herds of buffalo, they frequently congregate along the shoreline in the dry season. Other frequently encountered wildlife includes elephant and hippo, as well as waterbuck, sable and roan antelope. The reserve is also rich in birdlife, with many species of herons, storks, plovers, bee-eaters and geese, as well as the ubiquitous fish eagle, inhabiting the river banks. Arrival at the lodge airstrip, meet the lodge ranger and transfer to the lodge. Lunch at the lodge (depending on arrival time) Enjoy afternoon game drive. Dinner at the lodge with an overnight stay.
