Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: DAY 1: Victoria Falls

Arrival into Victoria Falls Airport, meet your English Speaking Guide and transfer to your hotel. A World Heritage Site, Victoria Falls is one of the world's greatest natural spectacles and the stuff of legends, romance and myth. Long before the Scottish missionary and explorer Dr David Livingstone 'discovered' the Victoria Falls in 1855, the local Batonga people had named them Mosi-oa-Tunya, 'the smoke that thunders'. Livingstone had named the Falls after his queen. Today, the town rightly claims the title of Adrenaline Capital of Africa, home to a seemingly endless variety of adventure sports from bungee jumping to canoeing and white water rafting. Lunch at the hotel (own account – depending on arrival time). Rest of day / evening at leisure.

Day 02: DAY 2: Victoria Falls

Day 03: DAY 3: Hwange National Park

After breakfast. Transfer to Victoria Falls Airport, proceed to check in for your onward flight to Hwange National Park Zimbabwe's largest national park, the elephant stronghold of Hwange is a game-rich area roughly the size of the Bahamas that was once the royal hunting grounds of the Ndebele warrior king Mzilikazi. It was proclaimed a national park in 1929.Hwange National Park is a land of contrasts from dense teak and acacia forest to vast open savannah, offering guests an exhibition of raw and diverse Africa. Lunch at the lodge (depending on arrival time). Rest of the day at leisure Enjoy shared afternoon game drive. Dinner at the lodge followed by overnight stay.

Your English Driver will hand you over to your lodge ranger who will transfer you in 4x4 to your lodge in the Chobe National Park Botswana's famous Chobe National Park is a must-see wildlife destination that includes the Savute Channel and natural beauty of the Linyanti River. Chobe covers almost 11,000 km²



(6,836 square miles), was the country's first national park and boasts the biggest concentration of wildlife in Africa. Famous for its large concentration of elephant and buffalo, which congregate along the Chobe River, Chobe National Park offers adventures such as game drives, private river cruises, excellent birdwatching and exceptional photographic opportunities. Arrival at the lodge and relax. 15:00 Afternoon tea is served on the open-air patio. 15:30 Depart for shared Chobe River Cruise No Chobe safari is complete without experiencing the beauty of the Chobe River and its incredible wildlife by boat.Unlike any other water-based activity in Botswana, the game viewing while on a river safari in Chobe is unsurpassed anywhere in Botswana. Elephant line the water's edge, hippo congregate in lagoons, hundreds of antelope and giraffe make their way to the water and sightings of predators along the river banks are common. 19:00 Arrive back at the lodge followed by dinner at 1930 hrs in the dinning area and overnight stay.

Day 06: DAY 6: Chobe National Park

Early morning wake-up call. BELOW TIME VARY ON SEASON – BELOWIS BASED ON WINTER SCHEDULE – SUMMER TIMES ARE 30mins EARLIER 05:00 Tea, coffee, rusks, muffins, fruit and a selection of fruit juices are served in the main public gathering area in front of Linyati Bar. 05:30 Leave for shared morning activity, (approximately 3 – 4 hours). 07:30 Breakfast is served in the dining area. 11:00 Optional mid-morning Chobe River safari. 12:30 Lunch is served in the dining area. 15:00 Afternoon tea is served on the open-air patio. 15:30 Depart for shared afternoon activity (approximately 3 hours). 19:00 Arrive back at the lodge. 19:30 Dinner is served in the dining area. Day 07: DAY 7: Okavango Delta

Early morning game drive followed by breakfast at the lodge. Transfer to the Kasane Airport for your onward shared charter flight to the Okavango Delta Known as "the river that never finds the sea", crystal clear channels spread over the thirstlands of the Kalahari with their papyrus-fringed banks and fertile floating islands. Adapted for a life in and out of water, the elegant red lechwe and shy sitatunga are found in this watery wilderness. Lion, cheetah, leopard and African wild dog share the floodplains with large herds of elephant and buffalo. Lunch at the lodge / camp. Afternoon game drive. Dinner at the lodge with an overnight stay.

Day 08: DAY 8: Okavango Delta

All meals at the lodge / camp .Enjoy morning and afternoon game activities with the lodge / camp .Explore the Okavango Delta by mokoro or motorised boat cruises (seasonal)*, on foot or on game drive. A maze of sparkling lagoons, meandering channels and overgrown islands teeming with wildlife, Botswana's Okavango Delta lies like a sparkling jewel at the heart of the Kalahari Desert. Adapted for a life in and out of water, the elegant red lechwe and shy sitatunga are found in this watery wilderness. Lion, cheetah, leopard and African wild dog share the floodplains with large herds of elephant and buffalo. Overnight stay.

Breakfast at the lodge / camp Transfer to lodge / camp airstrip for your shared onward charter flight to Moremi Game Reserve. The only proclaimed wildlife reserve in the Okavango Delta, Moremi Game Reserve (and its spectacular Khwai area) is also widely regarded as the most beautiful. Moremi Game Reserve has the most diverse habitat and animal populations in Botswana. The reserve contains about a quarter of the Okavango Delta and stretches across several thousand square kilometres, comprising a stunning landscape of forests, lagoons, floodplains and islands. Lunch at the lodge / camp Enjoy shared afternoon game drive at the lodge / camp Dinner at the lodge / camp.
