## Detailed Itinerary

### Day 01: Day 1. Airport/Rome

Upon arrival at Rome Fiumicino airport, transfer to your hotel. Free time at leisure. Overnight at hotel.

### Day 02: Day 2. Rome / Vatican Museums (Sunday and religious Holiday Closed\*)

After breakfast, enjoy a guided half-day tour to Vatican Museums. Reach the meeting point then, by coach, you will arrive at the Vatican Walls. Your guide will then lead you into the Vatican Museums and the famous Sistine Chapel, with its magnificent fresco of the Last Judgement. The tour will end in St. Peter Square. Time free at leisure in the afternoon. Overnight at hotel. (B) \*Not available on Sundays, January 01st and 06th, February 11th, March 19th, Eastern Monday, May 1st, June 29th, August 15th, December 08th and 25th and 26th

### Day 03: Day 3. Rome/Florence

Breakfast at hotel. Transfer from hotel to Rome railway station on your own. Leave Rome to Florence by rail. Upon arrival in Florence, transfer to hotel on your own. Overnight. (B)

### Day 04: Day 4. Florence / Uffizi Gallery (Monday Closed)\*\*

Breakfast at hotel. Reach the meeting point. The first part of the tour is an enlightening walking with a local guide who will unveil you the Cradle of the Renaissance. You will discover the stunning Santa Croce Basilica (outside), one of the best achievements of Italian Gothic style and the final resting place of Italian artists as Michelangelo, Galileo Galilei and Niccolò Machiavelli. You will also see The Old Bridge, one of the symbols of Florence, then reach Signoria Square to admire the Palazzo Vecchio and the famous Loggia de' Lanzi, a real open air museum. The tour finishes inside Uffizi Gallery, where you can admire the masterpieces of the great Italian artists, such as Botticelli's Birth of Venus, Leonardo's Annunciation, to name a few. You can remain in the Uffizi Gallery until closing time. Overnight at hotel. (B) \*\*Not available on Nov 3rd and 6th, Dec 1st and 25th, Jan 1st and 5th, Feb 2nd,, Mar 1st

### Day 05: Day 5. Florence/Venice

Breakfast at hotel. Reach on your own the railway station for departure to Venice by high speed train. Upon your arrival in Venice transfer on your own to the hotel. Time at leisure to discover this unique city. Overnight. (B)

### Day 06: Day 6. Venice



Breakfast at hotel. Reach the meeting point and enjoy a guided walk through the most characteristic places for the history of Venice. Among other highlights you will discover St. Mark's Square with the impressive Basilica (outside). Overnight at your hotel. (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Sharing boat transfer to Venice Airport according with your flight schedule. End of services. (B)
