# **Detailed Itinerary**

#### Day 01: Day 1 Nairobi - Samburu Game Reserve

Guest's will be collected early from Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport or a city hotel and depart for Samburu at 0800hrs, heading north, you'll pass near Thika and continue north through some breathtaking scenery dotted with rushing mountain streams and fields of tea and coffee. After Nanyuki town, you'll continue north and eventually reach a dusty outpost known as Isiolo, the last major stop on the journey into the remote northern frontier district. From here it's a short hop to Samburu. Arrive at the camp in time for lunch before departing for an afternoon game drive returning to the camp as the sun sets. Overnight at Elephant Bedroom Camp in a standard tent on a full board basis including selected house drinks Elephant Bedroom Camp Set on the banks of the Ewaso Nyiro River in the renowned Samburu Game Reserve, surrounded by palms and other beautiful indigenous trees lies this small and intimate tented camp with simplistic elegance, luxury, and style. Inspired by the textures and colours of African nature, each of the 12 beautifully appointed tents surround you with luxury. The en-suite bathrooms are fitted with hot & cold running water, rain showers and flushing toilets. Individual verandas encourage guests to linger while admiring the lush wilderness of the area. Elephant Bedroom Camp promises an astonishing safari experience as the name of the camp couldn't be more fitting. At night elephants, buffalos and hippos roam through the camp in search for food and water and hearing them from the warmth of your duvet covered bed is a truly exciting and memorable experience. The cosy lounge and dining area with original oil paintings and soft intimate lighting open to the outside capturing the tranquil surroundings. Dining is a culinary experience with al-fresco meals and candle lit gourmet dinners set either under the African sky or inside the romantic dining area. Enjoy game viewing of huge herds of elephant, prides of lion or the solitary leopard amongst other game with an expert local guide by open Land Rover. To stay at Elephant Bedroom Camp is to discover a unique place; to be a witness of its personal service together with the excitement of the African bush certainly provides a feeling of being privileged.

#### Day 02: Day 2 Samburu Game Reserve

Early morning game drive is followed by breakfast and time to relax by the river's bank. After lunch there will be a further game drive and a sundowner before returning to the camp. Overnight at Elephant Bedroom Camp in a standard tent on a full board basis including selected house drinks

#### Day 03: Day 3 Samburu Game Reserve – Great Rift Valley

Leaving Samburu behind, you'll travel south through Isiolo, crossing the northernmost foothills of Mount Kenya, until you get to the town of Nanyuki. Here you'll head west to Nyahururu, still known to many as Thomson's falls for its 237-foot cascade. Now travel in a southerly direction to Lake Nakuru, arriving at the



camp in time for lunch. After lunch, enjoy an escorted walk on the grounds of the camp. Overnight at Mbweha Camp on full board basis excluding drinks (see drinks supplement if required) Mbweha Camp Tucked away in the spectacular vastness of The Great Rift Valley on a private 6400-acre Congreve Conservancy, Mbweha Camp is nestled up against the southern border of Lake Nakuru National Park with beautiful views of the Eburu and Mau Ranges. 10 cottages built of lava stone and thatched makuti roof add glamour and style to its contemporary African ambience. Every cottage is surrounded by Candelabra Euphobia, yellow barked Acacia and other indigenous trees that provide a relaxed atmosphere as you listen to the African night sounds of a lion roar or the laughter of the hyena in the distance. Bush walks, night game drives, sundowners or bush breakfast are additional activities that you can enjoy and enhance your stay in truly remarkable and authentic African setting.

## Day 04: Day 4 Great Rift Valley

After breakfast depart with a picnic lunch for a full day game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park, returning to the camp as the sunsets. Overnight at Mbweha Camp on full board basis excluding drinks (see drinks supplement if required)

### Day 05: Day 5 Lake Nakuru - Masai Mara Game Reserve

After an early breakfast, you head for Njoro town, where you begin your ascent up over the top of the Mau Escarpment. Then, heading due south, travel towards Narok, the gateway to the Maasai Mara and district headquarters of this part of Maasailand. You'll travel across the "breadbasket" of Kenya, covered with acres of wheat and barley, before you reach the Mara in the time for lunch. After lunch, enjoy an afternoon game drive in the famous Masai Mara National Reserve, before returning to the camp as the sunsets. Overnight at Tipilikwani Mara Camp in standard tent on a full board basis excluding drinks (see drinks supplement if required) Tipilikwani Mara Camp Set on the banks of the Talek River overlooking the Mara plains, Tipilikwani Mara Camp has one of the most spectacular views available. The Maasai Mara is home to the wildebeest migration – one of the Seven Natural Wonders of the World - as well as to some of the most abundant wildlife populations in Africa! The 20 luxury tents lure discerning travellers with the cosy atmosphere and beautiful surroundings they offer. Each en-suite tent is equipped with all amenities and has its own terrace. Two large adjoining tents sharing a common verandah are the ideal setting for families. The dining and lounge area reflect the ambience of a tented camp but provides the comfort and protection of a permanent building. The open-sided design affords a unique, magical view across the river to the rolling plains dotted with game. Enjoy an al-fresco breakfast or wind down with a glass of wine at the campfire watching the spectacular sunset. Elephant, leopard, buffalo, rhino, and lion roam free – at ease in a protected, natural environment. Activities on offer include game drives accompanied by expert local guides, bush walks, and hot air ballooning at dawn (at extra cost). Tipilikwani offers an elegant yet relaxed atmosphere for experiencing the full adventure of the African bush



#### Day 06: Day 6 Masai Mara Game Reserve

Early morning and afternoon game drives in the Masai Mara. Overnight at Tipilikwani Mara Camp in standard tent on a full board basis excluding drinks (see drinks supplement if required)

#### Day 07: Day 7 Masai Mara Game Reserve - Nairobi

After an early breakfast you'll depart the Masai Mara and head across acres of rolling wheat and barley farms to Narok, the district headquarters of this part of Maasailand. From here cross the vast plains on the floor of the Rift Valley whilst keeping an eye out for herds of giraffe and gazelle before heading up the rift escarpment on a road built by Italian prisoners during World War II. You'll arrive into Kenya's bustling capital around mid day. On arrival in Nairobi guest will be dropped of at a city center hotel or Jomo Kenyatta airport for their onward flight.
