Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 1: Arrive Baku

Arrival to Baku. Meeting at the international airport and escort local guide to the hotel, including co-sightseeing tour of the city. Guided Tour will be along the central streets, green parks and the main attractions of the city. Hotel accommodation. Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 02: Day 2: Baku-Absheron-Baku

Morning breakfast at the hotel. At 10:00 - We leave for a tour of the Absheron peninsula. This day tour is presented on the Absheron Peninsula, as well as the Temple of Fire Worshippers (Ateshgyah), oil wells, castle in Ramana, Mountain with an eternal flame. Excursion to the ancient sites and castles of Absheron Peninsula dated XII-XIII centuries. Tour to the Old City of Baku (IcheriSheher), the largest capital in the Transcaucasian region. Sightseeing tour of the town includes Shamakhy Gates, caravanserai, Maiden's Tower, Palace of the Shirvan Shahs, Mosques, Carpet store. We suggest you to walk along the boulevard. Baku Boulevard - one of the sights of Baku, a favorite vacation spot of Baku and guests. In 2009 it celebrated its 100 anniversary. The length of the park, amounting at the moment 16 kilometers, after general reconstruction will be 25 km. Return to hotel Overnight at Hotel.

Day 03: Day 3: Baku-Guba-Baku

Morning breakfast at the hotel. At 09:00 - Leaving Baku and go route to Guba, One of the most beautiful cities of the country Guba is especially pretty in the spring, when its gardens and parks are blooming. Guba is attractive with its green nature, forests and mountain areas, which is a part of range of Caucasus mountains. Guba is famous for its apples which have long become its symbol. Khinalig is one of the oldest small mountain village in the world. Its age is more than 5,000 years. This is the highest and most isolated settlement in the Great Caucasian mountains, located on the border with Dagestan, 63 km from Guba. Its residents numbering about 2,000, still retain unique cultural traditions, speak their own language and wear their own traditional clothes. Trip to Krasnaya Sloboda village. Visit to the popular places as Qachresh forest, Tengealti canyon, Afurdja waterfall. Visit to the Juma mosque, Carpet factory Trip to Khinalig (Xinaliq) village. Return to Baku city at 20:00 - Return to Hotel.

Day 04: Day 4: Baku-Gobustan-Baku

Morning breakfast in the hotel. At 10:00 - Excursion to Gobustan. Located west of the settlement of Gobustan, about 40 miles (64 km) southwest of the center of Baku on the west bank of the Caspian Sea. In 2007 Gobustan was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site considered to be of "outstanding universal value" for the quality and density of its rock art engravings, for the substantial evidence the collection of rock art images presents for hunting, fauna, flora and lifestyles in pre-historic times and for the cultural continuity between prehistoric and medieval times that the site reflects. Excursion to the Museum of Heydar Aliyev Center. Heydar Aliyev Center is an area of 619000 square feet. The building complex in Baku on the draft Iraqi-British architect ZahaHadid, and is known for its distinctive architecture. Centre named after HeydarAliyev, the Azerbaijani leader. In the center there are meeting rooms (auditorium), galleries and museums. The project will play an important role in the intellectual life of the city. At 20:00 - Return to the hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 05: Day 5 - Baku-Gabala

Morning breakfast in the Hotel. Going to Gabala Gabala is the ancient capital of Caucasian Albania. Archaeological evidence indicates that the city functioned as the capital of Caucasian Albania as early as 4th century BC. The Ruins of the ancient town are situated 15 km from the regional center, allocated on the territory between Garachay and Jurluchay rivers. Gabala was located in the middle of the 2,500-year-old Silk Road, and was mentioned by Pliny the Younger as "Kabalaka", Greek geographer Ptolemy as "Khabala", Arabic historian Ahmadibn Yahya al Baladhuri as "Khazar". In the 19th century, the Azerbaijani historian AbbasguluB akikhanov mentioned in his book GulistaniIrem that Kbala or Khabala were in fact Gabala 200 km from Baku. Cable car. Nohurgol" Lake - Nohur lake which existed as a natural lake, Swimming in the Nohur lake is prohibited, however, fishing is allowed here – this is one of the main entertainment attractions that people enjoy near this place. You can even have a small voyage on a boat. Return to Baku. Overnight at hotel.

Day 06: Day 6 - Baku

Morning breakfast at the hotel. Highland Park: Highland Park, located in the heart of Baku and one of the favorite leisure places of the local residents, is regarded as one of the most beautiful parks of the capital city for a long time. Another commonly known name of the park among people is Viewing Square. At 10:00 - Baku Ferris Wheel, also known as the Baku Eye. The wheel is 60 meters (200 feet) high and has 30 cabins, each is holding eight people. It makes a complete turn in 30 to 40 minutes. We offer shine shopping and visit the most fashionable shopping centers in Baku. Ganclik Mall shopping center is located 2 minutes walk from the metro station Ganclik Baku metro. The building has all the architectural attributes of the East and the modern art of the West. It consists of five floors, including two underground floors. It also has parking for

550 cars. The center contains about 99 stores, ranging from 50 square meters to 370 meters in size, a large 1207 square meter supermarket, a cinema hall 6, a planetarium and a Cinema plus bowling halls, etc. Also in the shopping center there are restaurants offering different types of cuisine in the style of the local and European cuisine. Return to the Hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 07: Day 7 - Baku Departure

Morning breakfast at the hotel. Leisure time till transfer to Airport.

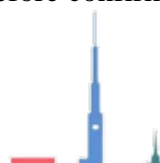
