

Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Day 01: Arrival in Istanbul

Arrival in Istanbul. Meet transfer assistant after luggage claim and customs area; then transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul.

Day 02: Day 02: Istanbul

Breakfast at hotel. The day will be at leisure. Overnight in Istanbul. (B) Optional Tour: After breakfast at hotel, depart for a full day tour including visits to Hagia Sophia, Hippodrome, Blue Mosque, Grand Bazaar and Topkapi Palace.

Day 03: Day 03: Istanbul

Breakfast at hotel. The day will be at leisure. Overnight in Istanbul. (B) Optional Tour: After breakfast at hotel, depart for a full day tour including visits to Spice Market, cruise on the Bosphorus with regular boat, Beylerbeyi Palace and Camlica Hill.

After breakfast depart for Istanbul Airport for the flight to Kayseri. Upon arrival transfer to Cappadocia and visit Ayval? Village and Kaymakl? Underground City. At the end of the tour transfer to hotel in Cappadocia. Overnight in Cappadocia. (B)

Optional: Early in the morning optional balloon ride. After breakfast, have a full day tour including visits to Göreme Open Air Museum, Pasabag, Avanos and Pigeon Valley. Overnight in Cappadocia. (B) Optional: Walking tour with Walking Mehmet, who is the most famous local man who knows the region and valleys better than anyone. Have a 1-hour tour with Mehmet and discover the unknown face of Cappadocia.

Day 06: Day 06: Cappadocia- Konya-Pamukkale

After breakfast, depart for Pamukkale via Konya and visit Sultanhani Caravanserai and Mausoleum of Mevlana en route. Overnight in Pamukkale. (B)

Day 07: Day 07: Pamukkale-Kusadasi-Izmir-Istanbul



Breakfast at hotel. In the morning visit Hierapolis. Then transfer to Kusadasi and visit Ephesus and The House of Virgin Mary. At the end of the tour transfer to Izmir Airport for the flight to Istanbul. Upon arrival meet transfer assistant after luggage claim; then transfer to your hotel. Overnight in Istanbul. (B)
