Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Cochin

On arrival in Kochi & transfer to Hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Kochi.

Day 02: In Cochin

After breakfast at hotel, proceed for sightseeing of Kochi visiting the Dutch Palace, the Jewish Synagogue - (which remains closed on Fridays) St. Francis Church and the Santa Cruz Basilica. While driving along the coastline, at the Harbour's mouth, one can also view the unique and still-in-use "Chinese Fishing Nets" which were introduced by the Chinese traders in the 14th Century. The tour ends in the Fort Kochi area where you can walk through the historical Dutch and Portuguese buildings. Some parts of this nearly 500-year-old Fort are still amazingly well preserved. Evening: Witness India's most spectacular Kathakali Dance show drama based on stories from Ramayana and Mahabharata. The dancers are elaborately made up with paint and masks, accompanied with drummers and musicians. Overnight at the hotel in Kochi.

Day 03: Kochi – Munnar (150 kms / 4 hrs drive approx)

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel & travel by road to the hill station of Munnar this afternoon, an idyllic haven of crisp mountain air, and tea. Upon arrival check-in at Hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Munnar.

Day 04: In Munnar

After breakfast excursion to Eravikulam National Park is 15 Kms from Munnar and has an area of 97 km². The park is located along the Western Ghats and has the largest viable population of the Nilgiri Tahr. The park also has other animals such as Nilgiri marten, ruddy mongoose, small clawed otter, dusky striped squirrel, Sambar Deer, Golden Jackal, Wild Dog, Indian Porcupine, and Funambulus etc. There are many species of birds too such as Nilgiri Wood Pigeon, White Bellied Short-wing, and Black-and-orange



Flycatcher etc. Overnight at the hotel in Munnar.

Day 05: Munnar – Periyar (130 kms / 3 hrs drive approx)

After breakfast drive to Thekkady. The drive Munnar to Periyar will be an unforgettable experience through the cardamom hills and by the valleys and hills. This will be one of the best drive you have during this tour. The very sound of the word Thekkady conjures up images of elephants, unending chains of hills and spice scented plantations. In the Periyar forest of Thekkady is one of the finest wildlife reserves in India, and spread across the entire district are picturesque plantations and hill towns that hold great opportunities for treks and mountain walks. On arrival check in at Hotel. Free to explore. Overnight at the hotel in Periyar.

Day 06: In Periyar

After breakfast proceed with boat ride at Periyar Wild Life Sanctuary. Periyar tiger Reserve, Thekkady, is an example of nature's bounty, with great scenic charm, rich bio diversity and providing veritable visitor satisfaction. Sprawled over an area of 777 Sq.km. Periyar is one of the 27 tiger reserves in India. Zealously guarded and efficiently managed reserve is a repository of rare, endemic and endangered flora and fauna and forms the major watershed of two important rivers of Kerala, the Periyar and Pamba. Proceed with boat ride at Periyar Wild Life Sanctuary. In the evening, enjoy Kalaripayattu performance. It's a gift to the modern world and known as the mother of all martial arts. Kalaripayattu originated in ancient South India. Kalaripayattu is a Dravidian martial art from the Indian state of Kerala. One of the oldest fighting systems in existence, it is practiced in Kerala and by the Nadars, Ezhavas as well as Mappilas and Syrian Malabar Nasranis. Kalaripayattu includes strikes, kicks, grappling, preset forms, weaponry and healing methods. Overnight at the hotel in Periyar.

Day 07: Periyar – Alleppey (140 kms / 4 hrs drive approx)

Drive to Alleppey & check-in to Houseboat, Your house boat carries you slowly down palm-hung waterways, past backwater settlements of thatched and tiled cottages, bright with cartons and hibiscus. You set your own pace: stopping where you like, resting when you like, and indulging yourself with the freshest of foods bought from the farmers and fishermen on the banks of the backwaters. You are always within the reach of other people & yet no one can intrude into your lives if you don't want them to. Overnight at the hotel in Alleppey Houseboat.

Day 08: Alleppey – Kovalam (160 kms / 4 hrs drive approx)

Early in the morning you can have the panoramic view of sunrise from your houseboat. After breakfast disembark your houseboat and drive to Kovalam. Free at leisure to explore. Overnight at the hotel in Kovalam.



Day 09: Kovalam – Trivandrum – Kovalam (18 kms/50 min approx)

After breakfast visit Kovalam city sightseeing as per below details. • Sri Padmanabhaswamy Temple: This 260-year old temple has a Gopuram that rises 30 meters in the sky and intricately carved pillars which are beautiful. (Non Hindus are not allowed inside of temple) • Napier Museum: This is an art and natural history museum which houses a collection of archaeological and historic artefacts, bronze idols, ancient ornaments, a temple chariot and ivory carvings. (Closed on Mondays, Wednesdays & Govt. Holidays) • Chitralayam Art Gallery: See works by renowned painters Raja Ravi Varma and Nicholas Roerich as well as examples of Mughal and Tanjore art. If time permits then also see Zoological Gardens. Overnight at the hotel in Kovalam.

Day 10: In Kovalam

Day at leisure. Overnight at the hotel in Kovalam.

Day 11: Kovalam – Trivandrum – Out

After breakfast transfer to airport to connect flight for onward destination.
