Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Buenos Aires

Arrival at Ezeiza International Airport (EZE) - Meet with your guide and private transfer to hotel. Mineral water on board included. The name, Buenos Aires, literally means "good airs" in Spanish. It is one of the largest cities in Latin America, with a wide range of cultural offers and stunning sights. Being the capital of the country makes it the starting point for most of the Argentinean Experiences. Let yourself be seduced by its busy and beautiful streets full of Tango aromas and football passion, a unique mixture that turns your stay into an exceptional urban adventure. 2 overnights accommodations at Carles Hotel - Executive Room with breakfast included. Buenos Aires 3 hours City Tour - Premium Shared Regular Premium Service (Shared) | Guided Tour in Spanish or English (1 language per vehicle, according to request) | Duration: Half Day (3 hours) - AM & PM Daily Departures | Van up to 12 seats maximum | Pick up from no more than 3 hotels | Includes 3 stops: Plaza de Mayo, Caminito at La Boca and cemetery of Recoleta | Lunch is not included. This tour provides an overview of Buenos Aires and does not include time to stop and enter museums or attractions that you will see while exploring the city. Discover the beauty and magic of Buenos Aires with this panoramic tour. The tour is 3 hours long and visits the most important highlights of this spectacular city. At the first stop discover the history of May Square, the site of the most important historical events and their protagonists since its foundation: see its surroundings, the most emblematic buildings, and learn all about them. Continue for a visit to the oldest residential neighbourhood in Buenos Aires: San Telmo, with its cobble-stoned streets and discover its antique shops and picturesque buildings. Live and feel the original Tango in the neighbourhood of La Boca: walk along Caminito Street and enjoy the dancers and souvenir shops. See the mythical Boca Juniors soccer stadium. Contemplate the modernization of the city whilst traveling along Puerto Madero and its exclusive docks, full of excellent restaurants and large offices. Pass through the Retiro neighbourhood and move on to see the most exclusive residential area before finally arriving at Recoleta. Once there, discover the final resting place of Eva Peron, "Evita" and wander through Recoleta Cemetery where she is to be found. This tour provides an overview of Buenos Aires and does not include time to stop and enter museums or attractions that you will see while exploring the city. Lunch is not included. Observations: This Regular Premium (Shared) tour can be organized on private basis upon request. Guests can end the sightseeing in Recoleta and continue on their own, or go back to the hotel. Dinner & Tango Show at La Ventana 3 course dinner & live Tango Show with shared transfers and drinks included.

Day 02: Buenos Aires

Tigre & Delta Tour with boat ride | Premium Shared Regular Premium Service (Shared) | Guided tour in Spanish & English | Duration: Full Day (6 hours) | Vehicle: up to 12 pax seats Van | Pick up from no more than 3 hotels | Includes Premium Motor Boat Navigation between Puerto Madero and Tigre - Visits to Puerto de Frutos and other Tigre highlights, such as San Isidro | Snacks along the way included. Our small group tour service to Tigre is unique within the market due to its characteristics and the services it offers, such as traveling from Buenos Aires to the Delta in a first-class motor launch with a small group. At the beginning of the tour, the group will make its way to the city's port to board a First Class motorboat which will take you to the Tigre Delta. During the one and a half hour trip our guests can admire Buenos Aires from The River Plate, its northern areas, and the Delta rivers, whilst enjoying refreshments on board. After the motorboat trip, a minibus will pick guests up and take you to visit Paseo Victorica, the most important neighbourhoods in Tigre and Puerto de Frutos, typical market. We will soon find ourselves in San Isidro where you will visit the town's historical centre and the cathedral on foot while having a snack, and then finally you will see the city's northern areas and the Presidential Residence in Olivos, before being taken back to your hotel.

Observations: This tour can be organized on private bases and customized upon request. Overnight at Carles Hotel.

Day 03: Buenos Aires - Cordoba

Private transfer from Hotel to Domestic Airport (AEP) with English speaking driver in order to take flight to Cordoba. Mineral water on board included. Flight from Buenos Aires to Cordoba - Not included Arrival at Cordoba (COR) Airport. Meet with your guide and private transfer to hotel. Mineral water on board included. Cordoba is the capital city of the homonymous province, it is one of the largest cities after Buenos Aires, located at around 700 km northwest from there with an impressive historical heritage dating back to its foundation in 1573. The city lies at the point where the pampas meet the mountains, it is a gateway to a landscape of green valleys, cascading streams and hills. Without a doubt the cultural capital apart from Buenos Aires. The Jesuits in its early development of the province were responsible largely for making this a city of learning, setting up one of the first universities in South America as well as many schools in the vicinity that are still functioning today. 2 overnights accommodations at Azur Real Boutique Hotel - Standard Room with breakfast included. Walking tour around Cordoba City Centre Private Service (Personalized) | Duration: 2:30 hours | English and Spanish guide at disposal| Tickets to the Jesuit Block are included | Water included during the tour. Visit of the Historic Centre where we will meet the majestic Cathedral Church, the Cabildo and the Plaza San Martín. Then, we will visit the Jesuit Block, an UNESCO World Heritage Site, made up of the Church of La Compañía de Jesús, the Rectorate of the National University and the Colegio Monserrat. We will continue the Tour through the streets of the Nueva Cordoba neighbourhood, the Paseo del Buen Pastor, the Church of the Capuchins (Neo-Gothic style construction from

the mid-20th century). On Saturdays and Sundays in the afternoon you can finish in Barrio Guyemes (district of artisans, galleries and gastronomic pole).

Day 04: Cordoba

Alta Gracia Half Day Tour Private Service (Personalized) | Duration: 4 hours (Half Day) | English and Spanish guide at disposal | Mineral water on board | Museum Tickets are not included. We will depart from Córdoba to the south. Along the way we will be surprised with the enigmatic monument to Myriam Stefford, who was the first Argentine aviator. Upon arrival in the city of Alta Gracia we will visit the Viceroy Liniers Museum, which is located inside the magnificent building of the former Jesuit Estancia Alta Gracia, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. We will visit its church dedicated to Nuestra Señora de la Merced, its courtyards and rooms and the Tajamar. We continue towards Villa Nydia, a chalet better known as the Casa Del Che, a house in which the Guevara family lived and which is reminiscent of Ernestito during his time in the city. Other museums and places available to visit are: Falla Museum, Dubois Art Museum, and Our Lady of Lourdes Grotto. MAM Museum of Archaeology. Overnight at Azur Real Boutique Hotel.

Day 05: Cordoba

Tradition Route & Jesuit Estancias Full Day Private Service (Personalized) | Duration: 8 hours (Full Day) | Vehicle and English speaking guide at disposal | Mineral water on board | Wine tasting, Museum tickets and 3-step Lunch (without beverages) are included | Maximum of 4 passengers to do the tour. Please ask for special departures for groups | Drop off at Estancia La Paz. We start the tour in the morning to our Northern Córdoba. Once in Jesús María, we will visit the Jesuit Ranch of the same name, a UNESCO World Heritage Site that houses an interesting National Museum. Here we will also discover the beginnings of winemaking activity in Córdoba, the place where the “Lagrimilla de Oro” was born, the first American wine served at the table of the Catholic kings. We continue our journey through a tunnel of lush centennial poplars in Caroya, until we reach the traditional Bodega la Caroyense to visit its facilities and taste its products. Before lunch we will recognize one of the most representative products of Caroya: its salami, at Norma Londero's, an artisan producer of this local delicacy. She will wait for us to let us know her place, her productions and taste her homemade flavours. Lunch will be held in an organic farm, where we can also visit his farm, his garden and a particular museum and blacksmith shop. In the afternoon we continue our journey into the corridor of the Sierras Chicas, where we will discover the impressive Estancia Santa Catalina, an imposing property where its church draws our greatest attention. We visit the interior of the church, its park and the old ranchería. 3 overnights accommodations at Pueblo Estancia La Paz – Classic room with half board included (beverages during dinner are not included). Conceived with the passion and desire to share a unique and welcoming place where history meets nature, the hotel is a sensory experience, where a sense of calm and wellness transports our guests far from everyday stress. The historic Casco central building, now housing the Roca

Suite and the Restaurant 1830, dates back to the XIX century and it was built by request of Julio Argentino Roca, twice President of Argentina, to make it his summer residence. The exotic park, designed by Charles Thays in 1900, together with its artificial lake and surrounded by the mountains, renders a beautiful, harmonious and unique setting. Program includes: - Accommodation. - Country breakfast. - Activities such as: Tennis Court and Riverside area by the Río Ascochinga. Check in: 02:00 p.m. Check out: 11:00 a.m.

Day 06: Cordoba
