Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival In Lima

Arrival in Lima at the international airport, either afternoon or evening. Transfer to hotel, meeting with personnel, and accommodation (private service). Overnight: Belmond Miraflores Park

Day 02: Lima

Breakfast in the hotel. In the morning: 4-hour city tour of Lima (including entrance fees to the Cathedral, San Francisco Convent, and their catacombs) (private service with an English-speaking guide). The afternoon is free. Overnight: Belmond Miraflores Park

Day 03: Lima - Cusco - Sacred Valley

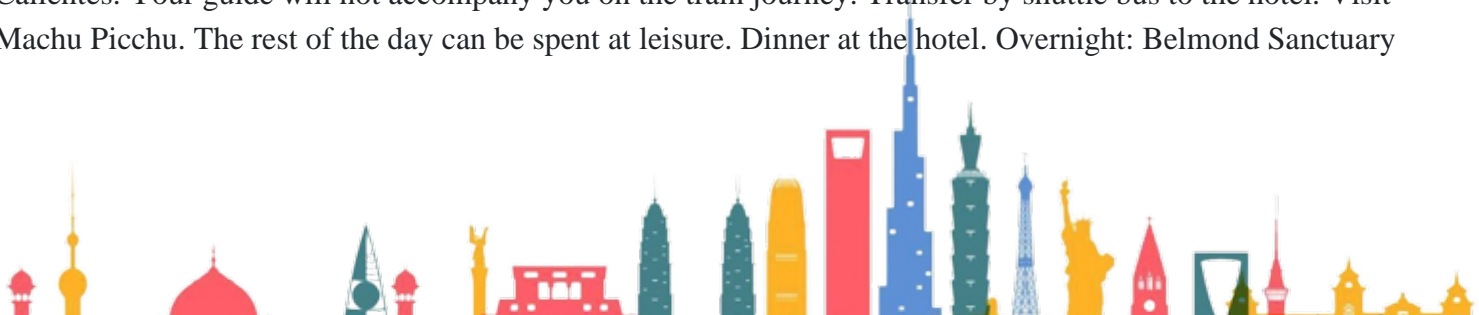
Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Cusco. Upon arrival in Cusco, depart to visit the Sacred Valley. Visit Awana Kancha, the PISAQ market, and lunch at Wayra Restaurant. The rest of the day can be spent at your leisure. Overnight: Belmond Rio Sagrado

Day 04: Sacred Valley

Breakfast at the hotel. Explore the fortress of Ollantaytambo, the Inca salt mines of Maras, and the ancient agricultural laboratory of Moray. Lunch with a tasting menu at MIL Centro restaurant (private service, English-speaking guide). Overnight: Belmond Rio Sagrado

Day 05: Sacred Valley - Aguas Calientes - Machu Picchu

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to Ollantaytambo Station for the Hiram-Bingham luxury train from Aguas Calientes. Your guide will not accompany you on the train journey. Transfer by shuttle bus to the hotel. Visit Machu Picchu. The rest of the day can be spent at leisure. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight: Belmond Sanctuary



Lodge

Day 06: Machu Picchu - Aguas Calientes - Cusco

Breakfast in the hotel. Meet your guide in the hotel lobby for a second trip to Machu Picchu. (Private services, English-speaking guides). After lunch, you will take a bus to Aguas Calientes and take the Hiram-Bingham luxury train from there to Ollantaytambo. (Your guide won't be with you on the train). Upon arrival in Cusco, you will be transferred to the Sacred Valley for the main luggage. (Around 2-hour journey).

Overnight: Belmond Palacio Nazarenas or Belmond Monasterio

Day 07: Cusco

Breakfast in the hotel. Morning walking tour of Cusco's historic center, San Blas neighborhood, and San Pedro Market (entrance to the Cathedral, and Santo Domingo/Coricancha are included). Visit the nearby ruins (Sacsayhuaman, Qenqo, Puca Pucara, and Tambomachay) after a 7-course lunch at MAP Cafe.

Overnight: Belmond Palacio Nazarenas or Belmond Monasterio

Day 08: Cusco - Lima

Breakfast in the hotel. Transfer to the airport for a flight to Lima.

Weather Preparedness

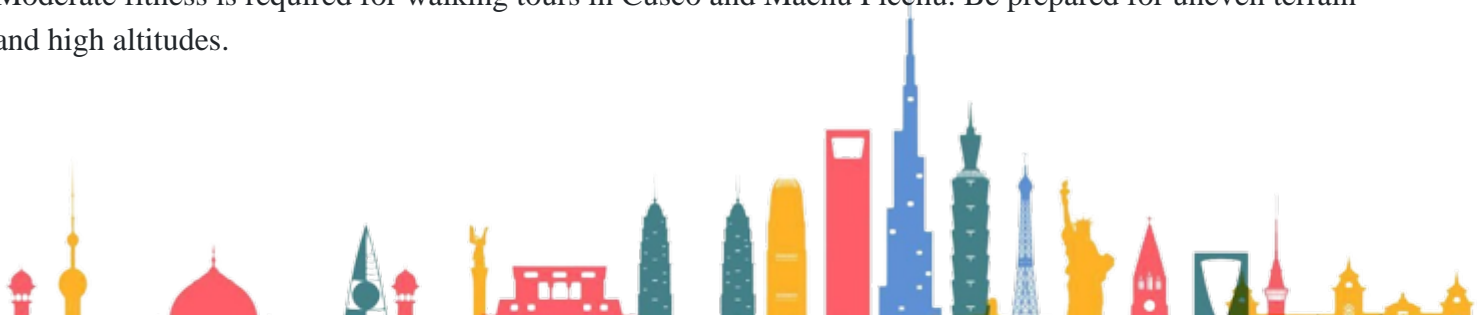
Lima: Expect mild weather, ranging between 60°F and 75°F (15°C to 24°C). Coastal fog is common.

Cusco and Sacred Valley: Cool mornings and evenings with temperatures ranging from 40°F to 68°F (4°C to 20°C). Warm layers are recommended.

Machu Picchu: Milder, humid conditions with a chance of rain. Dress in layers and carry rain protection.

Fitness Requirements

Moderate fitness is required for walking tours in Cusco and Machu Picchu. Be prepared for uneven terrain and high altitudes.



The second day at Machu Picchu offers the opportunity to explore more of the site, so comfortable walking shoes are essential.
