Day 01: Day 1: Arrival In Lima

Day 05: Day 5: Flight To Cusco And City Tour

After a morning flight from Lima to Cusco, you'll begin acclimating to the high altitude. In the afternoon, explore the city's rich Inca and colonial heritage. You will visit the imposing fortress of Sacsayhuamán, known for its enormous stone walls, followed by the religious site of Qenqo, and Puka Pukara, an ancient military complex. The tour ends with a walk through Cusco's vibrant historic centre, where narrow cobblestone streets lead to colourful markets, churches, and the beautiful Plaza de Armas. Overnight in

Day 06: Day 6: Sacred Valley Exploration

Enjoy a gourmet lunch at a local restaurant, and then return to your Cusco hotel for a restful evening, preparing for the following day's journey to Machu Picchu.

Day 07: Day 7: Machu Picchu Adventure

Board the luxurious Hiram Bingham train to Aguas Calientes, where you'll ascend to Machu Picchu, one of the Seven Wonders of the World. A guided tour will unveil the secrets of this ancient Inca citadel, where you'll explore the Sun Temple, terraces, and sacred spaces. The towering peaks and breathtaking views surrounding the site make this experience unforgettable. In the evening, return by train to Cusco, with memories of this incredible archaeological wonder. In the evening, relax at your hotel or explore Lima's renowned culinary scene, known as one of the best in the world.

Reflect on the incredible journey through Peru's diverse landscapes, from the Amazon rainforest to the Andes Mountains and the ancient ruins of the Inca Empire.
