Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Buenos Aires

Arrival at Ezeiza (EZE) International Airport. Meet with your guide and private transfer to your hotel. Mineral water on board. According to flight schedule, transfer can be arranged directly to hotel, or straight to the activity for the day. Buenos Aires Sightseeing Experience - South Area Private Service (Personalized) | Vehicle & English-speaking guide | Duration: Half Day (6 hours: 4 Touring + 2 Lunch Time) | Mineral water on board. The itinerary is liable to updates to provide better service according to the day, and inclusions agreed for the tour. We will visit Plaza de Mayo, the city's foundational site and witness of our country's political history. There we'll find the Pink House, our Presidential Palace, the Cabildo, our primitive town hall, and the Neoclassical-styled Metropolitan Cathedral, the final home of Argentina's founding father, José de San Martín. We'll then head for San Telmo, one of the oldest neighborhoods in Buenos Aires. It used to be the residential district favored by the upper class until late 19th century when a yellow fever epidemic caused the wealthier families to leave northwards. The area was marginalized until the 1970s when many artists and artisans came to San Telmo to install their workshops. Nowadays, thanks to its amazing architecture and hip atmosphere, this ancient neighborhood is really blooming. We'll walk its cobbled streets, where the city's Colonial past seems to come back to life, making a stop at Plaza Dorrego, best known for its traditional antiques fair, held every Sunday, along with the local Market. Leaving San Telmo behind, we'll continue southwards to La Boca, one of the city's most authentic and charming neighborhoods. It is a working-class district, heavily shaped by Italian immigrants who came to our country in large numbers during the last quarter of the 19th century. Here, we'll make a special visit to the mythical Caminito Street, which sums up everything that gives La Boca its distinctive spirit: the strong passion for soccer, the heavy presence of art and color, and the Tango esque atmosphere. At last, we'll pass through Puerto Madero, the latest addition to the city's neighborhoods. In 1991, its huge warehouses and silos were remodeled and redesigned, to finally integrate the river to the city and to create a new corporative, residential, hotel and gastronomically district, which has become the playground for the pretty Porteños and the international jet-set. During the itinerary, stop at Café Tortoni Remarkable Café, or similar Regular Service (shared venue) | BA Private Sightseeing's Supplement | Includes 1 coffee or classic hot chocolate with "churros" or pastries,

at this unique spot in the city. Stop for lunch at Cabaña Las Lilas Restaurant 3-course menu | Half a bottle of wine and one soft drink per person. 3 overnights accommodations at Legado Mítico Buenos Aires - Mythical Classic Double Room with breakfast included.

Day 02: Buenos Aires

Explore Buenos Aires North Area with a Bike Tour with Gourmet Picnic lunch in Palermo Parks Private Service (Personalized) | Specialized English-speaking guide at disposal | Duration: Half Day - 5 hours (4 hours Bike + 1- hour Picnic) | Gourmet Picnic Lunch includes: 1 basket every 2 guests with 1 Sandwich, 1 Salad, and 1 Dessert per guest, and Refreshments - Full set up with cutlery and picnic blanket | Private Transfer from Picnic area to hotel, with guide assistance included | Mineral Water on board included. Cycling guests will get to know the other face of the Buenos Aires, best known as the South American Paris. We will bike towards Retiro area, where we will encounter elegant hoods. We will then pass by the Floralis Generica, the MALBA Museum, and head into the Palermo Parks, where we will make a stop for a gourmet picnic lunch. We return to the Recoleta area, where we make a stop at the iconic cemetery. A great opportunity to take amazing photos; enjoy the fresh air and explore the city flow. Ideal for those looking for different ways of experiencing Buenos Aires at its best. During the ride, enjoy a Tango Moment at the Park Private Service (Personalized) | BA Private Sightseeing's Supplement | Tango Dancers couple & live Bandoneon private performance at the Park (15 to 20 minutes) | Available from Monday to Friday | Includes Champagne Toast and Snacks | 1 hour of vehicle and guide should be added for this supplement, depending on the rest of the activities during the tour. At some point we will make a brief stop in the park and a tango couple will be waiting for us to dance with a live "bandoneon" while enjoying a glass of champagne and snacks. After tour, transfer back to hotel. At night, Dinner & Show at Rojo Tango Regular Service (Shared Venue). 3 course dinner & live Tango Show, with private transfers - Soft drinks and wine included. Located inside the exclusive Faena Hotel, Rojo Tango - A cabaret designed by Phillippe Starck - is passion, madness and glamour in a history that ends transforming itself into a legend. Rojo Tango is a fascinating proposal that seduces all the senses combining sounds, fragrances, colours, movements and flavours. Overnight at Legado Mítico Buenos Aires.

Day 03: Buenos Aires

Gaucha Experience at The Pampas - La Bamba de Areco Ranch Private Service (Shared Venue) | Vehicle and English speaking guide at disposal | Duration: Full Day (8/9 hours) | Mineral water on board | Visit San Antonio de Areco Town, access to a local silversmith workshop & stop for a drink in a traditional Pulpería | Enjoy a Country Day at La Bamba de Areco Ranch (Relaix Chateaux Property) - Includes: Reception with

welcome drinks and empanadas, BBQ Lunch (with beverages and wine) + Traditional English Tea with cakes and pastries | Activities: Stroll in the Park, Horseback-riding, Cycling, etc. Visit to San Antonio de Areco town - Stop at silversmith workshops & Stop for "Vermouth" (or "vermú") at local Pulpería: The invitation is to immerse in the local environment of this historical town, the cultural legacy of Gauchos, Argentine traditions, local craftsmen and Fine Arts. An aromatized aperitif flavoured with various botanicals (roots, barks, flowers, seeds, herbs, and spices) typically served in town bars, is a local tradition visitor's shouldn't miss either! Ideally located only 120 km from Buenos Aires and close to San Antonio de Areco in the heart of the Pampa, one of the oldest estancias in Argentina, La Bamba successfully combines luxurious comfort and colonial elegance. The strolls in typical one-horse carriages called "sulkies", or just riding on horse-back, will show the visitors the enchantment of the Argentine land, the beautiful landscape, its growing crops, and let them feel the incomparable wild aroma in the air. An active part of Argentine and especially Gaucho Heritage, La Bamba de Areco is proud to offer authentic gaucho traditions such as "Asados" (BQQ) and Mate tastings, and organizes as an option several gaucho shows which are private and unique: musical entertainment with folk dances (additional, supplement not included), Indian horse-whispering, games of equestrian skill: patos, boleadoras and sortija. Observations: -Location: San Antonio de Areco - 120 km (1 hour, 20 minutes of land transfer from Buenos Aires downtown). -This Ranch does not allow children under 12 years old. -This Ranch also offers accommodation: Check for overnight programs. -Please note that La Bamba is proud to present the heritage of its region through a number of equine and folkloric demonstrations.
