Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Iguazu

Arrival at Puerto Iguazu (IGR) Airport - Meet with your guide and private transfer to hotel. Mineral water on board. According to flight schedule, transfer can be arranged directly to hotel, or straight to the activity for the day. Iguazu Waterfalls are located near the triple border between Argentina, Paraguay, and Brazil. They are composed by of 275 cascades and fed by the Iguazu river flow. The falls are split between Brazil and Argentina, being Argentina de country with over 80% of the extension of the waterfalls. One of the most important attractions in this place is "Garganta del Diablo" or "Devil's throat" which is the biggest fall of the complex (80 meters high). No matter if you decide to explore the waterfalls on the Argentinean side or if you want to contemplate them from Brazil, you may rest assured that the experience is a mesmerizing show. 2 overnights accommodations at Gran Melia Iguazu - Deluxe Jungle View Room with breakfast included. Brazilian Side Waterfalls Half Day Tour Private Service (Personalized) | Vehicle & English speaking guide | Duration: Half day (4 hours) | Includes 3-course lunch at Belmond Das Cataratas Hotel – Beverages are not included | National park tickets are included. The Iguazu National Park was created in 1939 by the Decree N° 1035. 35. It preserves the largest remnant of the Atlantic forest (semi-deciduous seasonal) in southern Brazil. The name of the Park refers to the Iguazú River, which in the Guaraní language means "big water". It has 185,262.5 thousand hectares and has enormous biodiversity. Get a close-up view of the Devil's Throat, from the Brazilian side. We will observe how 14 cascades of 350 feet (107 meters) precipitate with such force that a cloud of fog 100 feet (30 meters) high remains suspended above. This area is famous for its rainbows and the opportunities to get a photo of them! For a close-up of the falls, we will walk through the subtropical forest of the park to the base of Salto Floriano. Then we will take the elevator to the top of the falls to have the most wonderful views. Observations: * The itineraries are liable to updates in order to provide a better service. IMPORTANT: Please note that some countries require VISA to enter to BRAZIL.

Day 02: Iguazu

Argentinian Side Waterfalls Full Day Walking Tour Private Service (Personalized) | Vehicle & English speaking guide | Duration: Full day (6 hours) | Ecotax, National park tickets are included | 3-course Lunch with soft drinks and wine is included at the hotel's restaurant. The Iguazú National Park is located in the northwest of the province of Misiones and preserves the ecosystem of the Paraná jungle, an ecological region that covers almost the entire provincial territory. Its natural treasure is the Iguazú Falls: 275 waterfalls that reach an altitude of almost 80 meters (260 feet). Declared one of the New Seven Wonders of Nature in the World and also, Natural Heritage of Humanity. The Lower Circuit is made up of a trail approximately 1.3 km (0.6 miles) long that allows us to get closer to some of the smallest waterfalls on the Argentinian side. We will walk along the path, which is equipped with bathrooms and bars, and we will approach the Carlos Bozzetti waterfall, where you can take excellent photographs. The Superior Circuit, accessible for wheelchairs, allows us to see the top of the majestic waterfalls on the Argentinian side and enjoy an

impressive panoramic view of the area. The view stretches from the Argentinian Falls to San Martin Island and parts of the Brazilian Falls. The Devil's Throat is the largest waterfall in the region and where the greatest amount of water flows through the Iguazú Falls. At an impressive altitude of 107 meters (350 feet), the Devil's Throat is a must-see feature of Iguazu Falls. Thanks to the newly built walkway, it is possible to get quite close. Observations: * The itineraries are liable to updates in order to provide a better service. Great Adventure Regular Service (Shared) | Argentinian Falls side Private Tour's Supplement | guided tour in Spanish and English | Duration: 2 hours approx. The Great Adventure combines the essence of the Iguazú National Park: the jungle and the waterfalls in a single tour. Starting from its Operational Centre or from the Visitors Centre, we will enter the jungle through the narrow Yacaratiá Trail in units designed for this particular environment. This 5-km ride ends in the jungle base Puerto Macuco, from where we will descend 100 meters to reach the pier and board the boat with which we will go back 6 km through the Lower section of the Iguazú River canyon to the waterfall area, enjoying the mighty rivers rapid. We will arrive at the base of the Three Musketeers Falls, with a great view of Brazilian and Argentine falls, with the Devil's Throat. Afterwards, we will reach the most exciting point of the navigation when facing the incomparable San Martín Fall, second in terms of size and the largest that a boat can approach. To finish, we will disembark at the pier located in front of San Martín Island from where we can take the catwalks path, through the Lower Circuit. Observations: - We recommend bringing: Comfortable shoes, light clothing, insect repellent, sunscreen, raincoat/hood and extra clothing as you may finish the tour completely wet. - This activity is restricted to the following people: *Children under 12 years old *Pregnant women *People with osteoporosis, neck, back conditions or surgery *People with heart conditions or surgery *People with COPD or neurological condition or surgery *People with any physical, cognitive or/and sensorial disability unable to react in a nautical emergency in the rapids of the Iguazú river lower section. - The boat ride can be suspended due to bad weather conditions.

Day 03: Iguazu

La Lorenza Half Day Experience - Jungle & Kayak Private Service (Personalized) | Vehicle & English speaking guide | Duration: Half Day Activity (5 hours) | Argentine empanadas, cheese, cold cut platters and fruits | Drinks (water, flavoured water, beer and red wine) | Motorboat ride & Sit on top kayaks with lifejacket | Hand sanitizer, bug repellent spray, towel and poncho raincoat | Minimum 2 - Maximum 8 passengers | Ecotax is not included. La Lorenza is an ideal destination for nature lovers, birdwatchers, and photographers, and anyone looking for an authentic Atlantic rainforest experience. Is located 45-minutes' drive away from the city of Iguazú. Nestled in the forest, the property is located on the Paraná River, in a farm area where local families live off the land. Once we arrive at La Lorenza, a motorboat will be waiting for us to navigate up the Paraná River. After 15 minutes, we will reach the Yasy cascade, a local hidden gem. In the intimacy of this breath-taking natural landscape, we can chill out and enjoy nature. When we are ready, we will navigate down the river till we arrive at La Lorenza's coast, where the kayaks will be waiting for us.

A gentle paddle will take us to one of the Paraná's affluent, the Urugua-í River. This smaller river and its serene waters is a perfect place to contemplate nature and see the jungle from another perspective. After 2.5 miles of kayaking, we will be back on land. A 45 minutes' walk through the forest will take us to a privileged deck with an open view to Paraguay. Our visit ends at this unique spot. Observations: - Time schedule: Morning outing from 8:00 AM. Afternoon outing from 3:00 PM. During the winter season, from June to August, the suggested departure is at 2:00 pm and returning at 7 PM approx. - LEVEL OF DIFFICULTY: Low. The hike includes a pronounced 150-meter slope (approximately 500 feet). - This excursion is not recommended for children under the age of 8, pregnant women, people suffering any physical limitation. - Bring your passport (may be requested at checkpoints), covered footwear and long leg pants, even in the summer. Bathing suit and a change of clothes. You can also bring your reusable water bottle to be refilled as a way of reducing single-use plastic. - Please let us know in advance if you have any health problems, suffer from allergies or have any sort of dietary restrictions to adapt the menu. Private transfer from Hotel to Puerto Iguazu Airport (IGR) with English speaking guide. Mineral water on board.
